

TREASURED CEREMONIES

Availability: Is the celebrant available on the date and time you desire ?
If you find the right celebrant, can you change your date ?

Association membership: Check that the celebrant belongs to a celebrant association such as Celebrants Australia Inc.

Attitude: Is the celebrant tailoring a ceremony to your needs and wishes.
Does the celebrant have information and examples to help you design the ceremony together and as you want it.

Conflict: Will your wedding be the only one on the day ?
Find out also how early the celebrant usually arrives on the day.

Equipment: Does the celebrant have or have access to appropriate equipment such as computer and internet facilities, and a PA system at no further cost.

Experience: Is the celebrant experienced in conducting ceremonies?

Fees: Is the celebrant fee in the range and commensurate with the amount of work they will be doing? Too cheap and you might be disappointed.

Location: Is the celebrant within reasonable travelling distance to the venue or willing to travel without further cost to you ?

Personality: Does the celebrant project quiet confidence and have the sort of personality that you find attractive?

Professional: Does the celebrant appear professional and knowledgeable

Reliable: Does the celebrant wear the appropriate clothing, a reliable car, etc

Reputation: Are there some good testimonials on his website.

Training: Does the celebrant keep up his training annually or otherwise?
